- Aquarelle Arches pad is a much better-quality watercolor paper 9x12 140lb.COLD press. Or Canson Montval Watercolor Block 140lb. 9 x 12 Cold press.
- General's Kimberly Drawing Pencils Set of 10. Around \$11.00 Eraser.
- Winsor & Newton Masking Fluid (yellow).
- Winsor & Newton Watercolor tubes, a set of 6 or 12.
- Don't spend too much on brushes. You can purchase a "W.A. Portman LTD" set on Amazon for a reasonable price. The set includes flat, filbert, and round sizes in assorted sizes and the case.
- Clear Plastic 18" Ruler (Walmart sewing section).
- Blue Painters Tape ½."
- White foamboard comes in large sheets. (Dollar Store).
- A plastic mixing palette (tray) is preferable, such as Cheap Joe's original palette, which costs \$20 to \$17.
 -  A Plastic Container for water, paper towels, scissors, and other items you might have from a previous watercolor class.
